## 1 **Article 49B - Human Relations Commission** 2 3. 3 (a) The Commission may make surveys and studies concerning human (1) 4 relations, conditions, and problems, and it may promote in every way possible the 5 betterment of human relations. On the basis of studies or surveys, the Commission may recommend 6 (2) 7 to the Governor additional legislation or changes in existing legislation. 8 In making studies and surveys, it may expend any funds provided for (3)

- 10 (4) THE COMMISSION MAY <u>APPLY FOR AND</u> ACCEPT <del>GIFTS AND</del> GRANTS 11 FROM STATE, FEDERAL, AND PRIVATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS IN 12 FURTHERANCE OF ITS MISSION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 14 effect October 1, 2005.
