12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

15 38-104.

16 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a member of a State
17 system, who has not met the conditions set forth in § 38-103(a)(2) through (4) of this
18 subtitle, is entitled to receive service credit for military service only on the attainment
19 of 10 years of creditable service.

20 (b) (1) A member of a State system may not receive credit for that military
21 service if the member receives credit for military service from another retirement
22 system for which retirement benefits have been or will be received by the member.

23 (2) Paragraph (1) of this subsection does not apply to:

24 (i) credit for military service provided under:

25 1. the Social Security Act;
