The Board of Trustees shall reduce the pension of a retiree who has been 9 receiving an ordinary disability retirement allowance for: less than 10 years, by \$1 for every \$2 that the retiree's current (1) 11 compensation exceeds the limit under subsection (a) of this section; or 12 (2) at least 10 years, by \$1 for every \$5 that the retiree's current 13 compensation exceeds the limit under subsection (a) of this section. 14 The pension to be reduced under this section is the pension at retirement 15 without any cost-of-living adjustment.
