A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Bicycles and Motor Scooters - Exceptions to Requirement to**
3 **Stay Right**

4 FOR the purpose of creating certain additional exceptions to the requirement that a
5 person operating a bicycle or motor scooter stay as near to the right of the
6 roadway as is safe and practical; establishing that the requirement to stay to the
7 right only applies to a bicycle or motor scooter that is traveling at a speed less
8 than the normal speed of traffic; and generally relating to the requirement to
9 stay as near to the right of the roadway as is safe and practical while operating
10 a bicycle or motor scooter.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Transportation**

19 21-1205.

20 (a) Each person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter AT A SPEED LESS THAN
21 THE NORMAL SPEED OF TRAFFIC on a roadway shall ride as near to the right side of
22 the roadway as practicable and safe, except when [making]:

23 (1) MAKING or attempting to make a left turn[, when operating];

24 (2) OPERATING on a one-way street[, or when passing];

25 (3) PASSING a stopped or slower moving vehicle;

26 (4) AVOIDING PEDESTRIANS OR ROAD HAZARDS;

1 (5) APPROACHING A LOCATION WHERE A RIGHT TURN IS AUTHORIZED;
2 OR

3 (6) OPERATING IN A LANE THAT IS TOO NARROW FOR A BICYCLE OR
4 MOTOR SCOOTER AND A VEHICLE TO TRAVEL SAFELY SIDE BY SIDE WITHIN THE
5 LANE.

6 (b) Each person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter on a roadway may ride
7 two abreast only if the flow of traffic is unimpeded.

8 (c) Each person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter on a roadway shall
9 exercise due care when passing a vehicle.

10 (d) Each person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter on a roadway may walk
11 the bicycle or motor scooter on the right side of a highway if there is no sidewalk.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 October 1, 2005.
