- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) The clerk of each circuit court shall receive an annual salary for not more
- 17 than \$85,000 \$110,000} as set by the Board of Public Works on the basis of the
- 18 relative volume of business and receipts in the clerk's office.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
- 20 Section 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or
- 21 apply to the salary or compensation of the clerk of each circuit court in office on the
- 22 effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or

- 1 compensation of the clerk of each circuit court shall take effect at the beginning of the 2 next following term of office.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 3
- 4 October 1, 2005.
