- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) In this section, "accessory items" includes jewelry, watches, watchbands,
- 16 handbags, handkerchiefs, umbrellas, scarves, ties, headbands, and belt buckles.
- 17 (b) (1) [The week from August 10, 2001 through August 16, 2001] IN
- 18 ENTERPRISE ZONES, AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 83A, § 5-401 OF THE CODE, THE 5-DAY
- 19 PERIOD FROM AUGUST 24, 2005 THROUGH AUGUST 28, 2005, shall be a tax-free [week]
- 20 PERIOD for back-to-school shopping in Maryland during which the exemption under
- 21 paragraph (2) of this subsection shall apply.
- 22 (2) During the tax-free [week] PERIOD for back-to-school shopping
- 23 established under paragraph (1) of this subsection, the sales and use tax does not
- 24 apply to the sale of any item of clothing or footwear, excluding accessory items, if the
- 25 taxable price of the item of clothing or footwear is less than \$100.
