A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Juvenile Services - Intensive Alcohol Abuse and Drug Abuse Treatment -**
3 **Facilities**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Juvenile Services to establish and
5 maintain a certain minimum number of facilities that offer intensive alcohol
6 abuse and drug abuse treatment; requiring each facility to have a certain
7 minimum number of beds dedicated to intensive alcohol abuse and drug abuse
8 treatment; and generally relating to the provision of alcohol abuse and drug
9 abuse treatment for certain juveniles.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 83C - Juvenile Services**

18 2-117.

19 (C) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN AT LEAST
20 FOUR FACILITIES THAT OFFER INTENSIVE ALCOHOL ABUSE AND DRUG ABUSE
21 TREATMENT.

22 (2) EACH FACILITY SHALL HAVE AT LEAST 40 BEDS DEDICATED TO
23 INTENSIVE ALCOHOL ABUSE AND DRUG ABUSE TREATMENT.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
25 October 1, 2005.
