- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 (a) (1) In accordance with regulations adopted under this subtitle, [and if
- 16 adequate funds for the collection of DNA samples are appropriated in the State
- 17 budget.] an individual who is convicted of a felony or a violation of § 6-205 or § 6-206
- 18 of the Criminal Law Article shall:
- 19 (i) have a DNA sample collected on intake to a correctional facility,
- 20 if the individual is sentenced to a term of imprisonment; or
- 21 (ii) provide a DNA sample as a condition of sentence or probation, if
- 22 the individual is not sentenced to a term of imprisonment.
- 23 (2) [If adequate funds for the collection of DNA samples are
- 24 appropriated in the State budget, an] AN individual who was convicted of a felony or
- 25 a violation of § 6-205 or § 6-206 of the Criminal Law Article on or before October 1,
- 26 2003 and who remains confined in a correctional facility on or after October 1, 1999,
- 27 shall submit a DNA sample to the Department.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
