	WHEREAS, The Task Force to Study the Dynamics of Elderly and Retiree Migration Into and Out of Maryland was created by Chapter 525 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2004; and
17	WHEREAS, The Task Force was set to terminate on December 31, 2004; and
18 19	WHEREAS, Members of the Task Force were appointed in September 2004 and were not able to meet until October 2004; and
20 21	WHEREAS, the Task Force requires additional time to complete its study of the dynamics of elderly and retiree migration into and out of Maryland; now, therefore,
