- 25 INSTITUTION'S CAMPUS TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY RELATIONS COUNCIL.

- 22 ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION IS NOT ELIGIBLE
- 23 TO RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE STATE FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS.
