3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Small Business Development Center Network

- 4 Fund; specifying that the Fund is a special, nonlapsing fund, that the State
- 5 Treasurer shall hold the Fund separately, and that the Comptroller shall
- 6 account for the Fund; specifying that the Fund consists of certain revenues and
- 7 other moneys accepted for certain purposes; requiring certain investment
- 8 earnings to be credited to the General Fund of the State; allowing the Fund to be
- 9 used only for certain purposes; requiring the Governor to include in the annual
- 10 budget submission <u>bill</u> an appropriation from <u>a certain appropriation to</u> the
- 11 Fund; requiring a certain percentage of certain fees to be credited to the Fund;
- 12 providing that it is the intent of the General Assembly that the Governor

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "FUND" MEANS THE SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT 14 CENTER NETWORK FUND.

15 (B) THERE IS A SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER NETWORK FUND.

16 (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE FUND IS TO PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS FOR
17 FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS AND TO SUPPORT THE OPERATIONS OF THE SMALL
18 BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER NETWORK IN THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND.

19(D)THE FUND IS A SPECIAL, CONTINUOUS, NONLAPSING FUND THAT IS NOT20SUBJECT TO § 7-302 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE.

21 (E) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL HOLD THE FUND SEPARATELY, AND THE 22 COMPTROLLER SHALL ACCOUNT FOR THE FUND.

23 (F) THE PROCEEDS OF THE FUND SHALL BE INVESTED AND REINVESTED.

24 (G) ANY INVESTMENT EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE 25 GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

26 (H) THE FUND CONSISTS OF:

27 (1) REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FUND UNDER § 1 203(D) OF THE
 28 CORPORATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS ARTICLE; AND

- 29 (1) <u>ANY MONEY APPROPRIATED TO THE FUND;</u>
- 30 (2) ANY FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS; AND

31 (2) (3) ANY OTHER MONEY FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE ACCEPTED FOR 32 THE BENEFIT OF THE FUND.

(I) MONEY IN THE FUND MAY ONLY BE EXPENDED TO PROVIDE MATCHING
 FUNDS FOR FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS AND TO SUPPORT THE OPERATIONS OF THE
 SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER NETWORK.

4 (J) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR
 5 THEREAFTER, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET BILL A
 6 SPECIAL FUND APPROPRIATION FROM THE FUND TO THE UNIVERSITY OF
 7 MARYLAND, COLLEGE PARK FOR THE SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTER
 8 NETWORK GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION OF AT LEAST \$750,000 TO THE FUND.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the

10 General Assembly that the Governor provide an additional appropriation of \$250,000

11 for fiscal year 2006 to the University of Maryland, College Park for the Small

12 Business Development Center Network.

13 SECTION 2. <u>3.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 14 effect June 1, 2005.
