2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003 - Baltimore Zoo**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the date by which the Maryland Zoological Society
4 must provide evidence that a matching fund will be provided for a certain grant
5 provided in the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Chapter 204 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2003

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 Section 1(3)

13 ZA00 MISCELLANEOUS GRANT PROGRAMS

14 (B) Baltimore Zoo Redevelopment Projects. Provide a grant to the
15 Maryland Zoological Society to assist in the construction of
16 redevelopment projects at the Baltimore Zoo, subject to the
17 requirement that the grantee provide an equal and matching
18 fund for this purpose. The grantee may provide the matching
19 fund and the Board of Public Works may certify the matching
20 fund in installments during the period beginning with the
21 effective date of this Act and ending on June 1, [2006] 2008.

SENATE BILL 811

1 Each installment of the matching fund that the grantee
 2 provides shall be at least \$1,000,000. Except as specifically
 3 provided herein, the matching fund shall be subject to Section
 4 1(5) of this Act (Baltimore City).....3,500,000
 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
 6 effect June 1, 2005.
