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## 2 Public Safety - Deceased Military Member - Flag Presented to Family

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Secretary of State to issue a flag to the family of a

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (d) (1) The Secretary of State shall issue a State flag to the family of a
- 20 firefighter, policeman, MEMBER OF THE MILITARY, or sworn member of the office of
- 21 State Fire Marshal who is killed in the performance of duty.
- 22 (2) (I) [The] EXCEPT WHEN THE DECEASED IS A MEMBER OF THE
- 23 MILITARY, THE flag shall be presented to the family of the deceased by the State
- 24 Senator of the legislative district in which the deceased resided or served.
- 25 (II) WHEN THE DECEASED IS A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY, THE
- 26 FLAG SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE FAMILY OF THE DECEASED BY THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
