A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **On-Farm Food Establishments - Food Service - Regulation**

3 FOR the purpose of exempting certain on-farm food establishments from certain
4 Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and local government regulations
5 relating to a certain type of kitchen equipment; requiring certain on-farm food
6 establishments to be licensed as food establishments; providing that certain
7 on-farm food establishments are subject to certain food and safety
8 contamination regulations; requiring the health officer in each county where a
9 certain on-farm food establishment is licensed to inspect the on-farm food
10 establishment for compliance with certain food safety and contamination
11 regulations; and generally relating to the regulation of food service at on-farm
12 food establishments.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article - Health - General**

21 21-323.2.

22 (A) AN ON-FARM FOOD ESTABLISHMENT IS EXEMPT FROM ANY REGULATION
23 GOVERNING FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES THAT IS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR
24 A LOCAL GOVERNMENT RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OR INSTALLATION OF
25 COMMERCIAL GRADE KITCHEN EQUIPMENT IN THE ON-FARM FOOD
26 ESTABLISHMENT.

27 (B) EACH ON-FARM FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT INTENDS TO SERVE HOT
28 FOOD TO CUSTOMERS SHALL BE:

1 (1) LICENSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-305 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

2 (2) SUBJECT TO STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH REGULATIONS THAT
3 GOVERN FOOD SAFETY AND CONTAMINATION.

4 (C) IN EACH COUNTY, THE HEALTH OFFICER SHALL INSPECT EACH ON-FARM
5 FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT INTENDS TO SERVE HOT FOOD TO CUSTOMERS FOR
6 COMPLIANCE WITH FOOD SAFETY AND CONTAMINATION REGULATIONS IN
7 ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-313 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2005.
