- 22 (A) AN ON-FARM FOOD ESTABLISHMENT IS EXEMPT FROM ANY REGULATION
- 23 GOVERNING FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES THAT IS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR
- 24 A LOCAL GOVERNMENT RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OR INSTALLATION OF
- 25 COMMERCIAL GRADE KITCHEN EQUIPMENT IN THE ON-FARM FOOD
- 26 ESTABLISHMENT.
- 27 (B) EACH ON-FARM FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT INTENDS TO SERVE HOT
- 28 FOOD TO CUSTOMERS SHALL BE:

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- 1 (1) LICENSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-305 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
- 2 (2) SUBJECT TO STATE AND LOCAL HEALTH REGULATIONS THAT 3 GOVERN FOOD SAFETY AND CONTAMINATION.
- 4 (C) IN EACH COUNTY, THE HEALTH OFFICER SHALL INSPECT EACH ON-FARM
- 5 FOOD ESTABLISHMENT THAT INTENDS TO SERVE HOT FOOD TO CUSTOMERS FOR
- 6 COMPLIANCE WITH FOOD SAFETY AND CONTAMINATION REGULATIONS IN
- 7 ACCORDANCE WITH § 21-313 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
