- 1 (4) The Sunday deer hunting provisions under paragraph (3) of this 2 subsection do not apply: 3 In Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick, Harford, 4 Howard, Montgomery, Prince George's, Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties; 5 and 6 (ii) In Baltimore City. 7 A person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild (g) 8 bird or mammal may not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon 9 within 150 yards, known as the "safety zone," of a dwelling house, residence, 10 CHURCH, or other building or camp occupied by human beings, or shoot at any wild 11 bird or mammal while it is within this area, without the specific advance permission 12 of the owner or occupant. During any open hunting season, a person, other than the 13 owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within 14 the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
