- 19 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL A THROWING KNIFE TO A MINOR WITHOUT A 20 WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION FROM THE MINOR'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.
- 21 (C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR
- 22 AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 12 MONTHS
