3 **Exemption**

4 FOR the purpose of exempting a premises in a certain area in Anne Arundel County
5 from a certain floor space requirement for premises licensed to sell alcoholic
6 beverages; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Anne
7 Arundel County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 9-108.

22 (c) Except as provided in subsections (e), (f), [and] (g), AND (H) of this section,
23 a Board may not issue an alcoholic beverages license for use in premises in which
24 more than 10,000 square feet of floor space is devoted to off-sale use.

25 (H) SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IN ANNE ARUNDEL
26 COUNTY TO A PREMISES IN THE PAROLE GROWTH MANAGEMENT AREA THAT IS
27 BOUNDED BY SOMERVILLE ROAD ON THE NORTH, OLD SOLOMON'S ISLAND ROAD ON
28 THE EAST, FOREST DRIVE ON THE SOUTH, AND RIVA ROAD ON THE WEST.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 July 1, 2005.
