BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

[The] SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 18 (a) (1)

19 SUBSECTION, THE Board may require as a condition to issuance of a wetlands license

20 that compensation be made to the State, of a kind and in an amount deemed

21 appropriate by the Board.

22 FOR AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSE ISSUED FOR RIPARIAN (2)(I)

23 STRUCTURES OR ACTIVITIES WHERE THE STRUCTURE OR ACTIVITY IS NOT

24 INTENDED TO INCREASE REVENUE TO A COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE AND FOR WHICH

25 A PUBLIC HEARING IS NOT CONDUCTED, THE BOARD MAY NOT REQUIRE

(II) THE LIMIT ON REQUIRED COMPENSATION IN SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE RIPARIAN STRUCTURES OR ACTIVITIES ARE INTENDED TO IMPROVE NAVIGATION.

4 (b) Monetary compensation received by the State in conjunction with a 5 wetlands license may not be applied to the State annuity bond fund account.

6 (c) (1) There is created a special fund, known as the Tidal Wetlands 7 Compensation Fund.

8 (2) The following money shall be deposited in the Tidal Wetlands9 Compensation Fund:

10(i)Any monetary compensation paid to the State in conjunction11with a wetlands license, including compensation paid by an applicant instead of

12 engaging in the creation, restoration, or enhancement of a tidal wetland;

13(ii)Any penalty imposed by a court in accordance with this title;14 and

15 (iii) Any penalty imposed by the Department under this title.

(d) Funds in the Tidal Wetlands Compensation Fund may be appropriated
only for acquisition and conservation of wetland areas by the State, including cost
sharing assistance to landowners in the management and control of phragmites

19 under Title 8, Subtitle 21 of the Natural Resources Article.

20 (e) Funds appropriated in the budget for wetlands acquisition and 21 conservation under this section:

22 (1) Shall remain available until expended; and

23 (2) May not be reverted under any other provision of law.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 October 1, 2005.
