13 (4) Facilitate and support access to high quality technical resources for
 14 agricultural entrepreneurs by incorporating existing support infrastructure including
 15 the development of strategic partnering opportunities and business incubation;

16 (5) Foster cross-industry communication and assist other organizations 17 in transferring to the private sector and commercializing the results and products of 18 scientific agricultural research and development conducted by the federal

19 government and colleges and universities; and

20 (6) Work with public and private lending and grant-making institutions 21 to:

(i) Make low- and no-interest loans and loan guarantees available
 for agricultural product development, primary processing, and secondary
 manufacturing;

25 (ii) Provide credit and capital to first-time farmers for land, 26 equipment, and working capital acquisition; and

27 (iii) Make incentives available for activities related to small farm or28 small landowner viability and best management practices.

(D) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2016, THE GOVERNOR
30 SHALL INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET BILL AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CORPORATION IN
31 AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO AT LEAST \$4,500,000.
