- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 17 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provision of this Act for the
- 18 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 19 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 20 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or

- 1 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of funds expended prior to the
- 2 effective date of this Act. The fund may consist of real property or in kind
- 3 contributions. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what
- 4 money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall
- 5 determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 6 [2005] 2007, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a
- 7 matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall
- 8 certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the
- 9 proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for
- 10 the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of
- 11 the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of
- 12 no further effect.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 June 1, 2005.
