House Bill 1510 Judiciary (Delegate Cluster)

Juvenile Services - Detained or Committed Minors - Return of Personal Property to Owner

This bill requires the Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) to adopt regulations that set policies for the return of personal property to its owner on a child's release from detention or commitment in a DJS facility or its disposal if the owner cannot be located after being released from a DJS facility.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The requirements of this bill could be handled with existing budgeted resources. Furthermore, DJS advises that it currently has policies regarding the return of personal property.

Analysis

Current Law: DJS must adopt regulations that set policies for detention authorization, community detention, admission, transfer, discharge, and aftercare supervision.
