#### 6. Purpose of Bill

This bill authorizes a State Debt, the proceeds to be used as a grant to Moveable Feast for the design and construction of a new building which will enable the expansion of current services throughout Central Maryland and along the entire Eastern Shore.

# 7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the matching fund my be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions. The fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

## 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

Moveable Feast provides nutritionally appropriate meals and nutritional counseling to low income individuals and families struggling with HIV/AIDS who are homebound in the City of Baltimore, the five surrounding counties and the nine counties on Maryland's Eastern Shore. This regimen, when combined with drug therapies, most often improves the health of those who are not only infected, but very sick as well, thus reducing the the need for taxpayer financed hospitalization and other expensive medical care. Meal service is also provided to drop-in centers that serve the homeless, many of whom are HIV infected. A daily shuttle service called People on the Move is also provided to the homeless to assist them in getting from shelters to social service agencies and back again. In addition, Moveable Feast operates a culinary and life skills training program that prepares people with few, if any, marketable skills for jobs in the food service industry. And finally, the organization provides transportation for its clients to get them to and from medical appointments. A goal is to expand these services to include people with other life-threatening conditions, such as women with breast cancer.

#### 10. Description and Purpose of Project

Moveable Feast is currently renting space in the old Haussner's Restaurant building on Eastern Avenue in the Highlandtown section of Baltimore City. While the building holds fond memories for many, it is enormously expensive to maintain and almost twice the space needed to operate efficiently. Rent, water, gas and electric costs on average about \$13,000/month. Heating and cooling systems are unoperable in the kitchen and in much of the office space. The plumbing and wiring is antiquated and therefore poses potential hazards in use with today's office and kitchen equipment.
