#### **Ethics - Financial Disclosure Statements - Oath**

This bill repeals the requirement that a financial disclosure statement filed according to the Public Ethics Law be filed under oath.

# **Fiscal Summary**

## Analysis

**Current Law:** State officials and candidates for State office must file financial disclosure statements with the State Ethics Commission. The statements are filed under oath and the commission is required to develop procedures under which the reports may be filed electronically.
