### 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State debt, the proceeds to serve as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Maryland Salem Children's Trust, Inc. for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a new school building with classrooms, a kitchen and dining room, a media center, a mobile computer lab, a therapy room, an art and music room, and rest rooms, located in Frostburg in Garrett County.

#### 7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

# 8. Special Provisions

No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in coneection with the design, acquisition, or of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of divinity for any religious denomination.

# 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

Group homes and short-term shelter to provide home, family and mandated special education services to children abused, neglected, abandoned.

#### 10. Description and Purpose of Project

10,022-square foot centralized educational facility to house four classrooms, library, kitchen and dining room, offices and therapy rooms, replacing current residence and two unconnected modular units without kitchen. Health Department requires commercial kitchen.

Round all amounts to the nearest \$1,000. The totals in Items 11 (Estimated Capital Costs) and 12 (Proposed Funding Sources) must match. The proposed funding sources must not include the value of real property unless an equivalent value is shown under Estimated Capital Costs.
