FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 1093

(Delegate Barve)

Economic Matters

Commercial Law - Maryland Gasohol and Gasoline Products Marketing Act - Marketing Premises

This bill prohibits a distributor under the Maryland Gasohol and Gasoline Products Marketing Act from selling, transferring, or assigning to another person the distributor's interest in the marketing premises unless the distributor: (1) offers to sell, transfer, or assign the interest to the dealer (the retail seller of these products); or (2) if applicable, offers a right of first refusal of another person's offer to purchase to the dealer. If a distributor leases the marketing premises from a third party and subleases it to the dealer, the distributor may not sell, transfer, or assign the distributor's interest unless the distributor: (1) offers to sell, transfer, or assign that interest, as well as the distributor's interest in any improvements or equipment under specified circumstances to the dealer; or (2) if applicable, offers a right of first refusal of another person's offer to purchase to the dealer.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would not directly affect governmental finances or operations.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: A distributor's obligation toward a dealer when disposing of its interest in the marketing premises is not specifically governed by statute.

A person who violates a provision of the Maryland Gasohol and Gasoline Products Marketing Act is liable for damages caused by the violation and is subject to any other legal or equitable remedies available to the party injured by the violation.
