Senate Bill 513 (Senator Pipkin) Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Environmental Matters

Environment - Kent County - Sanitary Commission

This bill repeals the provision that the Kent County Sanitary Commission is comprised of five members and that each member serves a six-year term. Additionally, books, records, and minutes of the Kent County Sanitary Commission must be transferred to the Kent County Administrator.

Background: In May 2000, the Kent County Board of County Commissioners abolished the Kent County Sanitary Commission and established a Department of Water and Wastewater Services under the control of the Kent County Board of County Commissioners.
