6. Purpose of Bill

This bill funds a grant to the Anne Arundel County Tipton Airport Authority for the renovation of the control tower at Tipton Airport for use as an educational exhibit and organizational meeting place, located in Odenton.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

This grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the matching fund may be provided, directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the matching fund may consist of real property, or in kind contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

The Tipton Airport Authority was established by Anne Arundel County for the purpose of owning, operating, maintaining, and developing Tipton Airport, which operated as an U. S. Army facility until 1995. Tipton is now a public-use, general aviation airport. It provides facilities to support both government and private sector aviation, aviation related organizations, and local aviation education. The former Control Tower will provide meeting space for organizations such as the Civil Air Patrol, Coast Guard Auxiliary, and the Black Pilots Association. Additionally, it will support educational tours by groups such as the Boy Scouts and local schools

10. Description and Purpose of Project

The former Control Tower was constructed in 1960, but with the changing mission at Tipton, was decommissioned in 1988. While no longer needed for air traffic control purposes, the facility is ideal for supporting the aviation education needs of the surrounding area. The project will rehabiltate the Tower's observation area, approximately 250 square feet, five meeting rooms totalling aproximately 1,050 square feet, and a small rest room. Improvements include new ceilings, floor treatments, painting, windows, upgraded lighting and electrical, upgraded plumbing, and upgraded heating/ventilating/air conditioning. The common stairway in the Tower will be cleaned and painted. The exterior will be repainted in its existing red & white checkerboard pattern and parking will be improved. The improved Tower will support regular meetings by several aviation related organizations and visits by local school children and the general public.

Round all amounts to the nearest \$1,000. The totals in Items 11 (Estimated Capital Costs) and 12 (Proposed Funding Sources) must match. The proposed funding sources must not include the value of real property unless an equivalent value is shown under Estimated Capital Costs.
