Public Service Commission - License Hearing Officer

This departmental bill authorizes a Public Service Commission (PSC) license hearing officer to issue a proposed order and findings of fact stemming from a hearing related to for-hire driving services instead of making a recommendation to the commission. The proposed order is final unless appealed to the commission.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect PSC finances, although it could result in operational efficiencies.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: PSC has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Legislative Services concurs with this assessment.

Analysis

Current Law: A license hearing officer may hold a hearing involving a violation of the for-hire laws and regulations by a licensed for-hire driver and, except for a rate violation, by a holder of a taxicab permit. The hearing officer may recommend to PSC (1) the imposition of a civil penalty; (2) the suspension of a license or permit; or (3) the revocation of a license or permit.

PSC may then affirm, deny, or modify the recommendation of the license hearing officer.

Background: All other PSC hearing officers have the authority to issue proposed orders instead of making recommendations to the commission.
