Authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$300,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Baltimore County (Grantee) for the planning and design of a park in the northern section of Baltimore County			
<b>7. Matching Fund Requirements</b>			
Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the matching fund may be provided, directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

<b>9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b>			
Baltimore County, Maryland is a jurisdiction containing approximately 640 square miles and a current population of approximately 754,252 people, averaging 1,179 people/square mile. The population is predicted to rise to 803,500 by 2025. The jurisdiction currently boasts over 900 recreational sites in its inventory, consisting of both active and passive recreational lands.			
<b>10. Description and Purpose of Project</b>			
The County is negotiating to purchase a 171 acre parcel in northern Baltimore County. These funds would be used to design a park which would include athletic fields and other amenities.
