<b>6. Purpose of Bill</b>		
Authorizing the creation of a State debt, the proceeds to serve as a grant to the Board of Directors of Melwood Horticultural Training Center, Inc. for the design, construction, and capital equipping of a septic system to service the Melwood Retreat Center, which is used to provide services to individuals with developmental disabilities, located in Nanjemoy City.		
<b>7. Matching Fund Requirements</b>		
Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund of \$87,500. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.		
<b>8. Special Provisions</b>		
None		
<b>9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b>		
Melwood serves 1,800 persons, children through adult, with developmental disabilities. Services include job training, employment opportunities, residential alternatives, and recreational programming, promoting personal empowerment and social inclusion.		
<b>10. Description and Purpose of Project</b>		
Melwood cannot build two additional cabins (which are already funded) unless it complies with a recently imposed requirement by the Health Department to build a new septic system. Once completed, the new system will also accommodate additional cabins planned for the near future.
