6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of State debt the proceeds to fund the development and construction of the Environmental Education Center at NorthBay ELC. NorthBay is a \$36.9 million complex dedicated to environmental and character education for underprivileged youth statewide.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The Erickson Foundation is contributing and raising over \$33 million in private contributions for the entire NorthBay complex, of which the Environmental Education Center is a part.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

Specializing in underserved sixth-graders from around Maryland, NorthBay will present each school week a two part program focused 1.on delivering a state of the art environmental education program, and 2. on messaging students in the most compelling manner possible regarding issues of character, healthy choices, and their future. 350 sixth graders each week for 5 days, 10,000+ each school year, and 100,000 over the next decade will come face to face with the NorthBay experience. (25,000 kids/year with weekends and summers included.) NorthBay will implement a profound follow-up strategy, designed to provide an all-encompassing support environment for students as they return home, in order to keep the vision and behavior necessary for their goals to be realized.

10. Description and Purpose of Project

The Environmental Education Center (under construction and opening in September of 2005), features computer, microscope, video and art labs plus a display lounge, and 7 classroom spaces. A variety of conference and breakout spaces make this building the center of the educational experience for every student who spends a week at NorthBay. The Environmental Education Center, on the NorthBay complex, will partner with the Maryland State Department of Education and the DNR in educational programming.
