#### 6. Purpose of Bill

These Senate and House Bills provides the Grantee (County Executive and County Council of Anne Arundel County) until June 1, 2006 to expend or encumber the loan proceeds related to the Anne Arundel County - Wiley H. Bates High School Loan of 1998

## 7. Matching Fund Requirements

The grantee shall provide and expend a \$1,000,000 matching fund. No part of the matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the matching fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of the Act.

#### 8. Special Provisions

Grantee is required to conveyed to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest in the property.

### 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

Grantee is Anne Arundel County Government.

## 10. Description and Purpose of Project

At the end of the 2003 General Assembly session, Chapter 153 of the Acts of 2003 was enacted which requires grant recipients to expend capital funds within seven years from the effective date of the act that authorizes the grant; therefore, any capital funds authorized effective June 1, 1998 or prior will terminate by June 1, 2005, unless the capital funds have been spent or encumbered by the Board of Public Works.

In 1998, Senate Bill 162 and House Bill 190 created a State debt not to exceed \$1,000,000, as a grant to the County Executive and County Coucil of Anne Arundel County for the renovation, reconstruction and capital equipping, including asbestos removal and other infrastructure improvements, of the historic County owned Wiley H. Bates High School, in Annapolis, for use by Anne Arundel County as a Senior Center. In addition, the County intends to lease the remaining portion of the building for development of 71 senior apartments and a Boys & Girls Club facility.

This change in the law affects the bond funds awarded to Anne Arundel County in 1998 for the renovation and reconstruction of the high school.

The project schedule anticipates construction at the Wiiley H. Bates High School being completed in the Summer/Fall 2006; therefore, this Senate Bill 497 and House Bill 526 are amendments to the 1998 Senate and House Bills and extends the time period for Anne Arundel County to expend or encumber the grant proceeds until June 1, 2006.

Round all amounts to the nearest \$1,000. The totals in Items 11 (Estimated Capital Costs) and 12 (Proposed Funding Sources) must match. The proposed funding sources must not include the value of real property unless an equivalent value is shown under Estimated Capital Costs.
