<p>The purpose of authorizing the creation of state debt with the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Woods Community Center Inc/dba The Community Center, for the planning, design, construction, renovation, and capital equipping of the planned expansion of The Community Center in Severna Park, MD.</p>		
7. Matching Fund Requirements		
<p>Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the matching fund may be provided, directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the matching fund may consist of real property or in kind contributions. The matching fund may include funds expended prior to the effective date of this act.</p>		
8. Special Provisions		
<p>No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching fund may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of divinity for any religious denomination.</p>		
9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization		
<p>The Community Center is a 501c3 non-profit organization, open to all, that offers programs and activities for all ages, with particular focus on the youth and seniors of the Greater Severna Park area. The Center serves as a local facility for senior activities, as a county-operated Senior Center does not exist in Severna Park. Senior programs include health screenings and lectures, concerts, Bridge playing, and senior exercise programs. The youth center provides area youth with a safe, drug-free and alcohol-free place to gather. It house our After School Middle School Program, as well as a Friday Night Coffee House for high school age teens, and a Saturday night coffee house for college age and young adults. Our pools provide wellness programs, swim lessons, community swims, and is home to nationally recognized competitive swim teams, youth and masters.</p>		

10. Description and Purpose of Project			
Purpose:			
- Growth of senior population warrants the need for expanded services.			
- Limited current facilities prevents program expansion.			
- Increased demand for programs and activities for people of all ages and abilities. The Center's ability to do so is currently limited by an inadequate and outdated physical plant. The Center's future in making a vital contribution to our community is to respond to the needs of its residents and to grow as their needs grow.			
Description:			
Construction of 23,000 square feet (on two floors) that includes a new community gymnasium, 3 new meeting rooms, new dance/fitness studio, new weight room, new children's activity room, new community lounge, new entrance, offices, and storage areas.			
Reconfigure parking lot and outdoor plaza.
