<b>6. Purpose of Bill</b>		
The bill authorizes a state grant to the Board of Trustees of the Knights of St. John Hall, Inc. for the repair, renovation and capital equipping of the historic meeting hall, located in Bowie.		
<b>7. Matching Fund Requirements</b>		
No matching fund is required.		
<b>8. Special Provisions</b>		
No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or department of divinity for any religious denomination.		
<b>9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization</b>		
The Knights of St. John is a non -profit organization responsible for providing community service, assisting the needy and sick, and servicing the clergy and youth. The organization works with the City of Bowie and other groups to meet the needs of the citizens of the community.		
<b>10. Description and Purpose of Project</b>		
The purpose of the project is for the renovation of the Knights of St. John Hall. Renovations are needed in each of the following areas: a) repair or replace front steps to hall and basement; b) repair, replace, and upgrade foundation; c) upgrade and replace basement electrical service; d) install new basement doors and windows, and insulate basement; e) construct basement kitchen to support meeting hall; and f) construct building addition
