Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Election Law - Voter Registration Volunteers - Age Requirement

This bill allows an individual who is at least 18 years old or will be 18 years old by the day of the next succeeding general or special election to be a voter registration volunteer.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not materially affect governmental finances.

Analysis

Current Law: State law allows individuals to apply to become a registered voter with the assistance of a volunteer authorized by the State or local board of election. State Board of Elections regulations require a volunteer to be voting age.
