Authorizing the creation of a State debt, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of Camp ESPA, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and capital equipping of Camp ESPA, including replacement of the furnace and kitchen equipment and repairs to the sleeping quarters, plumbing and electrical systems, fire suppression system and the fishing pier, located in Rhodesdale.

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization			
Non Profit volunteer organization to help at risk and underprivileged children. To be mentor and friend. Promote good citizenship and build good character. With the objective to demonstrate to them that there is another side to life than they may be used to on the streets. Camp ESPA caststhe police officer in the role of friend and mentor.			
10. Description and Purpose of Project			
To bring the facilities into the standards set by the State. The electrical wiring must be replaced, the copper pipes will be replaced, a fire suppression system installed, replace the furnace, replace the ceilings in all rooms upstairs and down, the bathroom showers, rebuild the fishing pier, major repairs to the swimming pool and supply clothes and food for the children while they are at Camp ESPA.
