6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State debt, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Howard County for the renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping of the historic manor house known as Blandair Mansion and its outbuildings, located on 300 acres on Maryland Route 175 in Columbia.

7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

8. Special Provisions

This Bill requires the grantee to convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of its interest in the property.

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

Howard County Maryland is the Grantee organization. The Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks will coordinate this work with the U.S. Department of Interior, National Park Service. The Department of Recreation and Parks manages 8,000 acres of parkland and the historic buildings on that land, as well as conducts programs for the County's 270,000 residents. Blandair "restored" will preserve a critical element of the county's heritage and allow the Department to tell the story of Howard County farm life in the 1800's.

10. Description and Purpose of Project

This project consists of phase II of the preservation and rehabilitation of the historic Blandair Mansion and outbuildings which date back to the mid 1800's. The Blandair Farm was once owned by Theodoric Bland, who was the Chancellor of Maryland from 1824 to 1846. The mansion is constructed of brick, rising two and one half stories, totalling 8,000 square feet of living space. Stair cases, mantles and wood trim reflect the fine craftsmanship of bygone days. In addition to preserving this important landmark, the restored mansion will provide space for meetings, conferences, and a visitors center for a future 300 acre regional park. A park of this size draws around 150,000 visitors annually. The mansion and its outbuildings will create the following jobs: Historic Site Manager, Programming Specialist, Park Maintenance Worker and numerous part time docents. Phase II will address the interior of the mansion, structural elements, installation of utilities and outbuildings preservation.
