6. Purpose of Bill

The purpose of the bill is to provide a grant to the Board of Directors of The Highlands School for the planning, design, construction, and capital equipping of a school for children with learning disabilities to be located in Bel Air, Maryland

7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. The fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

8. Special Provisions

None

9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

The Highlands School is a private, non-profit school that serves children grades 2-8 with language processing deficits, Dyslexia, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) and other learning differences. It is the only school of its kind in Harford County and the only school in the Baltimore region with a stated mission of student remediation with the ultimate goal of a timely return to a traditional school. The Highlands School exists to identify and serve children who have the potential for average or above average achievement, ages seven(7) and older (Grades 2 through 8) who are struggling to learn by conventional methods and who manifest difficulties in one or more areas of skill development. These areas include:

Language - receptive (auditory processing) and expressive (communications)

Reading and Spelling Perceptual - motor integration (writing / copying tasks)

Organization -study and social skills

The program is designed to provide an environment conducive to fostering optimum growth in the child's overall educational competence, remediating skill deficits and permitting the student to transition to a traditional school in a timely manner.

The capital project will support this mission at the new facility which will serve up to 125 students in the full academic year program and up to 75 students in the five week - intensive summer school program.

10. Description and Purpose of Project

Scope of the Project:

The Highlands School capital building project for which funding of \$500,000 through a State of Maryland Bond Bill is being sought includes:

- · The acquisition of 18.5 acres of land located at 2409 Creswell Road, Bel Air, Harford County, Maryland
- Construction of a 25,000 square foot, one-level facility. This facility will accommodate:
- 1. 125 students
- 2. 12 classrooms
- 3. Media Center
- 4. Art Center
- 5. Music Center
- 6. Full Court Gymnasium
- 7. Environmental Classroom
- 8. Evaluation/Therapy Center
- 9. Multi-Purpose Room
- 10. Computer Lab
- 11. Science Lab

The cost of the project is \$5 million. The Committee is approaching foundations, individuals and corporations for funding in addition to requesting the Bond Bill.

Ground breaking is planned for the fall of 2005. We expect to accommodate 75 students during the first year of operation at our new facility. The second year student enrollment will increase to 100 and by the third year of operation a full complement of 125 students will be enrolled. Full time employment equivelency projection is 78.
