#### 6. Purpose of Bill

Authorizing the creation of a State debt, the proceeds to serve as a grant to the Board of Directors of World Arts Focus for the planning, design, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the World Arts Focus Community Arts Center, located in Mount Rainier.

## 7. Matching Fund Requirements

Prior to the payment of any funds, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching fund. No part of the fund may consist of in kind contributions. The fund may consist of real property or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act.

#### 9. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization

World Arts Focus at Joe's Movement Emporium is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt community arts organization that pomotes participation and practice in dance, movement, and performing arts traditions from around the world, while using the arts as a tool for community revitalization. By brining together local and international artists with community members to enjoy the arts and participate in unique programs and brilliant performances, WAF/Joe's creates better social and learning opportunities for under-served children; programs offering life-skills instruction for at-risk youth; and partnerships involving families, small businesses, government agencies, local schools, and peer organizations. WAF/Joe's offers community productions, family programming, weekly classes, weekend performances, and arts education programs for children and youth. Annually, WAF/Joe's serves 3,500 children and between 25,000 and 30,000 visitors, patrons, students, and artists.

#### 10. Description and Purpose of Project

WAF/Joe's curerntly attracts a core audience that feeds other businesses in the area. The renovation of a nearby warehouse at 3309 Bunker Hill Road in Mount Rainier, Maryland, will transform an under-utilized facility into a 20,000 sq. ft. community and performing arts center. With this new facility, WAF/Joe's will employ more artists, provide artists with more space to create and produce their work, attract larger audiences to weekly performances, offer larger venues for other nonprofit and civic groups to meet, provide more arts education programming to twice as many underserved children and at-risk youth, and allow more community members to learn about many performance traditions from around the world. The new facility will include a 150-seat performance theatre with backstage area, tech booth, and dimmer room (3,600 sq. ft.); three large studios for classes and rehearsals (1,200 sq. ft. each); a new Arts Education Center dedicated to kids (4,900 sq. ft); an outdoor performance area for summer concerts (1,300 sq. ft); a fully functional café with space for performances and meetings; affordable office and studio space for local artist and community organizations for classes, rehearsals, and children's programming; and up to eight individual studios for artist tenants (200-1000 sq. ft).
