House Bill 1198
Ways and Means

(St. Mary's County Delegation)

Education, Health, and Environmental
Affairs

St. Mary's County - Compensation Review Commission

This bill requires the St. Mary's County Compensation Review Commission to periodically review and make recommendations regarding the salaries and benefits for the members of the St. Mary's County Board of Education.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. This bill codifies current practice.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The seven-member St. Mary's County Compensation Review Commission is charged with reviewing the salaries and benefits for St. Mary's County officials. The commission is required to meet by December 1 each fourth year to make their recommendations.

Local Fiscal Effect: St. Mary's County advises that commission members do not receive compensation for their services. Furthermore, the commission voluntarily examined the salaries of the board of education members in December 2004, and made salary adjustment recommendations.
