House Bill 1498 Ways and Means (Delegate Hixson)

Task Force on the Regulation of the Horse Training Industry

This bill establishes a Task Force on the Regulation of the Horse Training Industry to study specified aspects of the horse training industry in Maryland. The Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation (DLLR) is required to provide staff for the task force. The task force is required to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly by December 1, 2005.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2005 and terminates December 31, 2005.

Fiscal Summary
