Ways and Means

#### Election Law - Voters' Authority to Cast Write-In Votes

This bill repeals the prohibition on casting a write-in vote in a primary election, thereby authorizing a voter to cast a write-in vote in a primary, general, or special election.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** One-time general fund expenditure of \$50,000 in FY 2006 and 2008 for the costs of reprogramming the gubernatorial and presidential primary electronic election ballots to include a field for write-in voting.

#### Analysis

**Current Law:** State law prohibits a voter from casting a write-in vote in a primary election. Write-in votes are allowed only in a general election or special general election for as many positions as are to be filled in a contest.
