## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 770 (Third Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Regulated" and substitute "<u>Human Service</u>"; in lines 11 and 17, in each instance, strike "<u>regulated</u>" and substitute "<u>human service</u>"; in line 13, after "<u>with</u>" insert "<u>certain human service facilities and</u>"; in line 16, after "<u>management</u>" insert "<u>and certain interested parties</u>"; and in the same line, after "<u>term</u>;" insert "<u>requiring the Governor's Office of Homeland Security to report to certain committees of the General Assembly on the implementation of this Act on or before a certain date; requiring the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to consult with certain providers of certain community mental health residential programs regarding the application of this Act;".</u>

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 35 and 36 and substitute:

## "(5) <u>A STATE-OPERATED INSTITUTION FOR MENTAL DISEASE;</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 33 and 34.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 1 and 2 and substitute:

# "(E) <u>A HUMAN SERVICE FACILITY SHALL PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE</u> EMERGENCY PLANS DEVELOPED UNDER THIS SECTION TO:

# (1) LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS FOR EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR PURPOSES OF COORDINATING LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING EFFORTS; AND

(2) <u>ANY INTERESTED PARTY, ON REQUEST.</u>";

after line 7, insert:

"<u>SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall consult with the providers of licensed community mental health residential programs following the adoption of regulations to implement this Act in order to evaluate whether the provisions of this Act also should apply to licensed community mental health residential programs.";

and in line 8, strike "<u>3.</u>" and substitute "<u>4.</u>".
