AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 880
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, strike “EMERGENCY BILL”; in line 5, strike “out-of-home placement” and substitute “facility licensed by the Department of Juvenile Services”; in the same line, strike “repealing” and substitute “altering”; in the same line, strike “defining a certain term;”; in line 6, strike “making this Act an emergency measure;” and substitute “authorizing the Governor to transfer certain positions and funds in a certain manner; making certain provisions of this Act subject to a certain contingency;”; and in line 11, strike “, 6-404, 6-405.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 3, 6, 7, and 11, in each instance, strike the bracket; in line 4, strike “and”; in line 6, after “operated” insert “; OR

(3) A RESIDENTIAL FACILITY LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT”;

in lines 7 and 11, strike “(D)” and “(E)”, respectively; and strike in their entirety lines 15 and 16.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 29 on page 2 through line 30 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 2, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENTS”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 25, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Governor may transfer 5 regular positions and \$271,000 for those positions from the Department of Juvenile Services to the Juvenile

(Over)

Justice Monitoring Unit of the Office of the Attorney General.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take effect October 1, 2006, contingent on the transfer of positions and funds under Section 2 of this Act. If the positions and funds are not transferred in accordance with Section 2 of this Act on or before October 1, 2006, this Act, with no further action of the General Assembly, shall be null and void and of no force and effect. The Juvenile Justice Monitoring Unit of the Office of the Attorney General, within 5 days of receiving a transfer under Section 2 of this Act, shall forward notice of the transfer to the Department of Legislative Services, 90 State Circle, Annapolis, Maryland 21401.”;

in line 26, strike “2.” and substitute “4.”; and strike beginning with “this” in line 26 down through “enacted” in line 30 and substitute “, except as provided in Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2006”.
