AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 331
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “Trust;” insert “requiring that certain maintenance, repairs, or improvements be conducted in accordance with certain policies and standards of the Department of General Services;”; and in line 7, after “consultant;” insert “requiring the Department to be responsible for ensuring that certain maintenance and repair takes place;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 22, after “(B)” insert ““DEPARTMENT” MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES.

(C)”;

and in line 25, strike “(C)” and substitute “(D)”.

On page 2, in line 4, before the first “THE” insert “(A)”; in the same line, after “FOLLOWING” insert “VOTING”; after line 8, insert:

“(B) THE TRUST CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING NONVOTING MEMBERS SERVING AS ADVISORS:

- (1) THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT;
- (2) THE STATE ARCHIVIST; AND
- (3) THE DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND HISTORICAL TRUST.”;

in line 12, before “IN” insert “(A)”; and after line 27, insert:

(Over)

“(B) ANY MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, OR IMPROVEMENT APPROVED BY THE TRUST UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DEPARTMENT’S POLICIES AND STANDARDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 2, strike “MAINTAIN AND RESTORE” and substitute “MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE TRUST REGARDING RESTORATION,”; in the same line, after “NECESSARY” insert “, TO”; after line 5, insert:

“(C) IF THE TRUST ACCEPTS THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CONSULTANT SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THEN THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THAT THE APPROPRIATE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR TAKES PLACE.”;

and in line 6, strike “(C)” and substitute “(D)”.
