AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 182
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after “Jurisdiction” insert “and Requirements”; in line 4, after “City;” insert “limiting the circumstances under which a special traffic enforcement officer in Baltimore City may exercise certain authority; requiring special traffic enforcement officers in Baltimore City to take an accredited conflict resolution training course; requiring the Police Commissioner of Baltimore City to keep certain records;”; in the same line, strike “the jurisdiction of”; after line 5, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
The Public Local Laws of Baltimore City
Section 16-16C(c)
Article 4 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1979 Edition and 1997 Supplement, and 2000 Supplement, as amended)”;

and after line 11, insert:

“BY adding to
The Public Local Laws of Baltimore City
Section 16-16C(f)
Article 4 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1979 Edition and 1997 Supplement, and 2000 Supplement, as amended)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 15, insert:

“(c) The Commissioner shall keep a record of:

(Over)

- (1) special traffic enforcement officer appointments; AND
- (2) THE COMPLETION OF AN ACCREDITED CONFLICT RESOLUTION TRAINING COURSE BY EACH SPECIAL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.”

On page 2, after line 1, insert:

“(F) EACH SPECIAL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT OFFICER SHALL COMPLETE AN ACCREDITED CONFLICT RESOLUTION TRAINING COURSE IN THE TIME PERIOD DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSIONER.”

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, in line 22, after “officer” insert “UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- (I) DURING REGULAR HIGH TRAFFIC PERIODS;
- (II) AS NECESSITATED BY AN EMERGENCY SITUATION OR INCIDENT; AND
- (III) IN CONNECTION WITH A SPECIAL EVENT”.
