AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1342
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Kullen” and substitute “Delegates Kullen, Barve, Benson, Boteler, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Frank, Hammen, Hubbard, Kach, Kohl, Mandel, McDonough, Morhaim, Murray, Nathan-Pulliam, Oaks, Pendergrass, Rudolph, V. Turner, and Weldon”; in line 8, after “submit” insert “a”; in the same line, strike “reports” and substitute “report”; in the same line, after “before” insert “a”; and in the same line, strike “dates” and substitute “date”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 5, strike “OCTOBER 1, 2006” and substitute “JANUARY 1, 2007”; in line 15, strike “October 1, 2007” and substitute “JANUARY 1, 2008”; and in line 16, strike “OCTOBER 1” and substitute “JANUARY 1”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 27, after “population” insert “and individuals with disabilities”; and in line 31, after “population” insert “and for individuals with disabilities”.

On page 5, strike line 4 in its entirety; in lines 5 and 6, strike “(ii)” and “(iii)”, respectively, and substitute “(i)” and “(ii)”, respectively; in lines 2 and 8, in each instance, after “population” insert “and for individuals with disabilities”; in line 13, after “to” insert “support individuals with disabilities and to”; in line 14, strike the third “and” and substitute:

“(6) The affordability of the types of services and programs for the age 65 and older population and for individuals with disabilities who may not qualify for federal, State, or local assistance; and”;

in line 15, strike “(6)” and substitute “(7)”; in line 16, after “population” insert “and individuals with disabilities”; strike beginning with “an” in line 19 down through the first “and” in line 20; and in line 20, strike “July” and substitute “December”.
