## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1102 (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with the first comma in line 2 down through "Counsel" in line 3; strike beginning with "altering" in line 5 down through "Act;" in line 18 and substitute "<u>altering the manner for selecting the Chairman of the Commission; altering the beginning of the term of office of the members and Chairman of the Commission;</u>"; in line 20, strike ", the People's Counsel, and the Office of People's Counsel"; and in line 23, strike ", 2-202, and 2-204" and substitute "<u>and 2-103</u>".

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 26 on page 1 through line 3 on page 2, inclusive.

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 10, strike "ONE COMMISSIONER" and substitute "<u>TWO</u> <u>COMMISSIONERS</u>"; in line 12, strike "ONE COMMISSIONER" and substitute "<u>TWO</u> <u>COMMISSIONERS</u>"; in line 13, after "DELEGATES;" insert "<u>AND</u>"; strike beginning with "ATTORNEY" in line 14 down through "THE" in line 15; in lines 17 and 18, in each instance, strike the bracket; strike in their entirety lines 19 through 24, inclusive; in line 26, strike "July 1" and substitute "<u>APRIL 10</u>"; and in line 28, strike "JULY 1" and substitute "<u>APRIL 10</u>".

On page 3, after line 4, insert:

## "<u>2-103.</u>

(a) [With the advice and consent of the Senate, the Governor shall appoint] FROM AMONG THE COMMISSIONERS, THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT a Chairman.

(b) (1) The term of the Chairman is 5 years and begins on [July 1] APRIL 10.

(Over)

(2) <u>At the end of a term, the Chairman continues to serve until a successor</u> qualifies.

(3) <u>A Chairman who is [appointed] ELECTED after a term has begun serves for</u> the rest of the term and until a successor qualifies.".

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 5 through 33, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 2, strike "June 30" and substitute "<u>April 9</u>"; in line 4, strike "July 1" and substitute "<u>April 10</u>"; in line 5, strike "one" and substitute "<u>the</u>"; in line 6, strike the first "the" and substitute "<u>one</u>"; in the same line, strike "Attorney General" and substitute "<u>Speaker of the House</u>"; in line 7, strike the first "the" and substitute "<u>one</u>"; in the same line, strike "Attorney General" and substitute "Speaker of the House" and substitute "<u>President of the Senate</u>"; in line 8, strike "Governor" and substitute "<u>Speaker of the House</u>"; in line 9, after the first "the" insert "<u>second</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 10 through 25, inclusive; and in line 26, strike "7." and substitute "<u>3</u>.".
