AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 793
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 2, after “County” insert “and Anne Arundel County”; strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 4 down through “vehicle” in line 6 and substitute “prohibiting a person under a certain age from standing in a roadway, median divider, or intersection in Montgomery County or Anne Arundel County to solicit certain money or donations from an occupant of a vehicle; providing for the enforcement of this Act in Montgomery County”; in line 7, after “County” insert “and Anne Arundel County”; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article - Transportation

Section 21-507(g) and (h)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2002 Replacement Volume and 2005 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

Strike in their entirety lines 17 through 20, inclusive, and substitute:

“(G) (1) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

(2) THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE ENFORCED BY THE ISSUANCE OF A WARNING THAT INFORMS THE OFFENDER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(H) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS MAY NOT STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.”.
